An Act to Amend the Secret Voting Provision Governing School Administrative District Budget Proceedings.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	20-A MRSA §1304, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 770, §1,
4	is amended to read:
6	6. Secret ballot. An article shall must be voted on by secret ballot if 10% a majority of those present and voting vote
8	to have a secret ballot.
10	STATEMENT OF FACT

L4	This bill requires a majority of people present and voting at a school administrative district budget meeting to approve the procedure of voting on the budget by secret ballot. Under
L6	current law, approval of that procedure requires the vote of only 10% of those present and voting.
