16	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its
18	place the following:
20	'Sec.1. 28-A MRSA §458 is enacted to read:
22	<u>§458. Renewal of agency liquor store license; selection of alternate licensee</u>
24	1. Application by store. The holder of an agency liquor
26	store license shall apply annually to the commission for renewal of that license. An application for renewal must be submitted on
28	a form prepared by the bureau.
30	2. Review by commission. In reviewing applications for renewal submitted under subsection 1, the commission shall
32	consider the following criteria:
34	A. The applicant's sales and inventory of liquor;
36	B. The applicant's sales and inventory of groceries and

40	<u>C. Any changes in the location of or renovations to the applicant's premises;</u>

If the commission denies an application for renewal of 6 an agency liquor store license, the commission may select an alternate licensee in accordance with the criteria set forth in 8 sections 453, 453-A and 453-B. If the alternate licensee held an agency liquor store license in the past, the commission may 10 consider any of the applicable criteria set forth in subsection 2 in considering whether to license the alternate agency liquor 12 <u>store.</u> 14 4. Purchase of store merchandise by State. If the commission does not renew the agency liquor store license, the 16 commission shall purchase from the agency liquor store all resalable spirits held in inventory by the agency liquor store. 18 The purchase price is the cost at which that agency liquor store 20 purchased the spirits from the commission, minus 10% of that cost. 5. Aggrieved applicant. Any agency liquor store licensee 22 aggrieved by a decision of the commission not to renew an agency 24 liquor store license may appeal the decision by filing a complaint with the Administrative Court and serving a copy of 26 that complaint on the commission. The complaint must be filed and served within 15 days of notification of the agency liquor 28 store licensee by the commission that the license will not be renewed. 30 32 FISCAL NOTE 34 The procedures established by this bill for agency liquor store license renewal will not appreciably affect General Fund 36 revenues. 38 The additional workload and administrative costs associated 40 with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.' 42 44 STATEMENT OF FACT 46 48 The amendment requires the State Liquor Commission to purchase back the agency liquor store's inventory if the commission denies renewal of the agency liquor store license. 50 The purchase price is the agency liquor store's cost minus 10%.

The amendment also makes clear that an agency liquor store licensee may appeal a State Liquor Commission decision not to renew an agency liquor store license to Administrative Court. Finally, the amendment clarifies language in the bill, corrects a cross-reference and adds a fiscal note.
