COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1452, L.D. 2064, Bill, "An Act to Provide an Exemption to the Sunday Fishing Ban When a Storm Advisory or Storm Warning Is in Effect"

Amend the bill in subsection 2 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 10 and 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "storm advisory or storm warning is in effect" and inserting in its place the following: 'hurricane warning issued by the National Weather Service is in effect for any coastal waters of the State'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that a hurricane warning issued by the National Weather Service must be in effect to permit the lawful raising, hauling or transfer of lobster traps in coastal waters on summer weekends.
