**An Act to Require That People Who Must Wear Corrective Lenses for  
Driving a Motor Vehicle Wear Corrective Lenses While Hunting.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7101, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

9. Visual impairment. A person who is required to wear corrective lenses for driving a motor vehicle shall wear corrective lenses while hunting. An indication of this restriction must appear on a hunting license issued to that person.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that people who must wear corrective lenses for driving a motor vehicle wear corrective lenses while hunting.
