An Act to Amend the Laws Regarding Licensing of Gravel Pits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

38 MRSA §483-B is enacted to read:

<u>§483-B. Borrow pit permit</u>

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Notwithstanding any rule administered or enforced by the department, a permit for a borrow pit mining activity involving the removal of sand, fill or gravel of more than 5 acres remains in effect for the duration of the mining operation at the borrow pit.

STATEMENT OF FACT

 16 This bill clarifies that a permit for a borrow pit mining activity remains in effect for the duration of the commercial
18 mining operation. The bill does not affect any other terms or conditions concerning the operation or reclamation of a borrow
20 pit.

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
