HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1462, L.D. 2074, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Financial Responsibility Laws"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§783-A.~~" in subsection 2 in the first line (page 2, line 43 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "notice" the following: 'from the court that issued the order' and in the 3rd line (page 2, line 45 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "State" the following: ', pursuant to chapter 17.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment clarifies who must give notice of a default in making installment payments before the Secretary of State suspends the judgment debtor's license, registration certificates or plates. The amendment also requires the Secretary of State to give a person who is alleged to have defaulted in making payments an opportunity for a hearing before the Secretary of State suspends that person's license, registration certificate or plates.
