STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the Passamaquoddy Tribe to place into trust
a small farm that the Tribe acquired from a member of the
Passamaquoddy Tribe in 1988. The tribal member and the member's
family continue to live on the property, which is located in
Albany Township, Oxford County.
