"Do you favor amending the Constitution of Maine to allow 2 the deputy treasurer of state to fill the vacant position of Treasurer of State and the first deputy secretary of state to fill the vacant position of Secretary of State until the Legislature elects a new Treasurer of State and Secretary of State during the current session if the Legislature is in 6 session when the vacancy occurs, or in the next regular or 8 special session of the Legislature if it is not in session?" ' 10 Further amend the resolution by inserting before 12 statement of fact the following:

The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 115th Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

This amendment clarifies the provisions of the bill by indicating the process for selection of a successor to the Secretary of State and the Treasurer of State if a vacancy occurs while the Legislature is in session. The amendment adds a fiscal note.
