An Act Concerning the Norridgewock Water District.

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Private and Special Law 1989, chapter 64 authorized the boundary expansion of the Norridgewock Water District pending a local referendum; and

Whereas, the referendum was to be held within 90 days after legislative approval of the expansion; and 10

Whereas, an extension is needed by the Town of Norridgewock for the purpose of approving the boundary expansion; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 18 safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1989, c. 64, §12 is amended to read:

Sec. 12. Referendum; emergency clause. Except for section 2, this Act shall-take takes effect when approved. Section 2 shall 26 take takes effect when approved only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the Town of 28 Norridgewock at a regular town meeting or at a special town meeting to be called and held for that purpose within-90-days-of 30 the-approval-of-this-Act before July 1, 1992. The regular or special town meeting shall must be called, 32 advertised and conducted according to the law relating to municipal election; provided that the selectmen municipal officers of the town shall 34 may not be required to prepare for posting, nor the town clerk to post, a new list of voters and for the purpose of registration of 36 voters the board of voter registration shall must be in session on the secular day next preceding the regular or special 38 The voters of the water district shall vote on the election. 40 following question:

"Shall the provision in the Act to amend the Norridgewock 42 Water District charter expanding the geographic boundaries of the district to include those parts of the Town of 44 Norridgewock not presently included in the district be accepted?" 46

48 The legal voters of the Town of Norridgewock not presently residing in the water district shall vote on the following 50 question:

"Shall the provision in the Act to amend the Norridgewock Water District charter expanding the geographic boundaries of the district to include those parts of the Town of Norridgewock not presently included in the district be accepted?"

Section 2 of this Act shall-take <u>takes</u> effect when approved 8 by a majority of both the legal voters of Norridgewock Water District and the legal voters of the remaining area of the Town 10 of Norridgewock not presently included in the district voting at the election.

Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to June 28, 1989.
