Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §252-I, sub-§§2 and 3, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 600, §1 and affected by §3, are amended to read:

2. Combat Infantry Award. Were awarded the Combat Infantry Award; or

3. Bronze Star. Were awarded the Bronze Star;

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §252-I, sub-§§3-A to 3-G are enacted to read:

3-A. Navy Cross. Were awarded the Navy Cross;

3-B. Distinguished Service Cross. Were awarded the Distinguished Service Cross;

3-C. Silver Star. Were awarded the Silver Star;

3-D. Distinguished Flying Cross. Were awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross;

3-E. Bronze Star Medal with Combat V. Were awarded the Bronze Star Medal with Combat V;

3-F. Air Medal with V. Were awarded the Air Medal with V;

3-G. Army Accommodation with V. Were awarded the Army Accommodation with V; or
