COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1503, L.D. 2116, Bill, "An Act to Reorganize the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§73." by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'The bureau must contain the following functional sections.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the first paragraph in the 3rd line (page 1, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Deputy Director, Clerk Typist III,"

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from the State Alcoholic Beverages Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides for the net deallocation of funds resulting from the elimination of one Retail Store Operations Director position, one Carpenter Foreman position and 3 Retail

4 positions. This deallocation will increase  
General Fund revenue by \$102,462 in fiscal  
6 year 1992-93.'

8 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the  
statement of fact the following:

22 This bill will result in a net reduction of 3 positions  
24 within the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and a deallocation from  
the State Alcoholic Beverages Fund of \$102,462 in fiscal year  
26 1992-93. This net deallocation will increase General Fund  
revenue by \$102,462 in fiscal year 1992-93.'

30 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

32 This amendment permits the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages to  
34 retain the positions of Deputy Director and Clerk Typist III.  
The amendment changes the wording of the bill to recognize the  
36 possible merger of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and the  
Bureau of the Lottery. The bill requires that new bureau to  
38 contain at least 2 sections, for liquor licensing and retail  
liquor store management and operations. The amendment also adds  
40 an allocation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
