STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-TWO

An Act to Reorganize the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages.

(EMERGENCY)

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Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the present state fiscal situation requires that the Legislature take all prudent fiscal steps to reduce government expenditures; and

Whereas, the health and welfare of the people of Maine are

10 enhanced by a consolidation of the operations of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages, resulting in increased attention to 12 licensing issues; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §73 is enacted to read:

- 24 §73. Organization of the bureau
- 26 The bureau is organized into 2 functional sections.
- Licensing. The licensing section is responsible for licensing agency stores and licensees, liquor tax auditing and
   overseeing malt liquor and wine operations.
- 32 <u>2. Merchandising.</u> The merchandising section is responsible for retail store management and operations.
- Sec. 2. Positions abolished. The following positions within the
  Department of Finance, Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages are
  abolished: Deputy Director, Clerk Typist III, Retail Store
  Operations Director, Carpenter Foreman and 3 Retail Store
  Supervisor positions.
- Sec. 3. Positions established. The following positions within 42 the Department of Finance, Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages are established: two Licensing Agents, at pay grade 16.
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Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 46 preamble, this Act takes effect July 1, 1992.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill directs the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages to 4 organize itself into 2 functional sections, licensing and merchandising. Seven positions are eliminated and 2 new 6 positions for Licensing Agents are established.

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
