COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1509, L.D. 2121, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Parking Violations that Occur on State Controlled Property within the Capitol Area"

Amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "\$2910." in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$30" and inserting in its place the following: '\$50'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

1992-93

REVENUES

General Fund \$1,500

Revising the minimum fines for parking violations on state controlled property within the capitol area will increase General Fund revenue by \$1,500 in fiscal year 1992-93. Costs associated with printing new tickets and rulemaking will be absorbed by the Department of Public Safety utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the increase in parking violations if a person is found guilty in court from \$30 to \$50 and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
