

SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1515, L.D. 2127, Bill, "An Act to Provide a Private Remedy for Violation of the Lead Poisoning Control Act"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 25 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Act" the following: 'in an action for equitable relief'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment limits lawsuits under the Unfair Trade Practices Act for Lead Poisoning Control Act violations to equitable relief. It does not change or affect current law as to a person's right to sue for damages.
