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**An Act to Provide a Private Remedy for Violation of the Lead Poisoning

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

6 Any person who violates any section of this chapter also  
8 violates the Maine Unfair Trade Practices Act.
