<u>§1527-A. Citizens' Advisory Group</u>

The authority shall appoint the Citizens' Advisory Group, as established by Title 5, section 12004-I, subsection 24-B, consisting of no less than 20 members broadly representing the people of the State, Representation must be sought to include individuals from business, labor, environmental groups, public interest organizations, low-level radioactive waste generators, municipal officials, governmental agencies and any other person or organization that expresses an interest in the subject of this chapter. 42 1. STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment creates the Citizens' Advisory Group to advise the Maine Low-level Radioactive Waste Authority. The Citizens' Advisory Group will be composed of no less than 20 members representing a broad cross-section of Maine's population. The Citizens' Advisory Group will meet at least 4 times a year. Members will receive expenses only for attending meetings of the Citizens' Advisory Group.
