36	association. It also repeals the section of law exempting solicitations for law enforcement officers running for public		
38	office.		
40	The amendment also repeals the legislative intent section of Public Law 1991, chapter 510, which amended the solicitation law in the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature.
