COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 830, L.D. 2134, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Solicitations by Police Officers"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §3702-A, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 510, §2, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §3703, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 449, is repealed.

Sec. 3. PL 1991, c. 510, §5 is repealed.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment repeals the section of Maine law prohibiting law enforcement officers from soliciting property from the general public when that property would tangibly benefit a law enforcement officer, agency or association. It also repeals the section of law exempting solicitations for law enforcement officers running for public office.

The amendment also repeals the legislative intent section of Public Law 1991, chapter 510, which amended the solicitation law in the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature.
