STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-TWO

An Act to Amend the Laws Concerning the Maine Court Facilities Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 MRSA §1606, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 438, §1, is amended to read: 4

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6 Limitation on securities issued. 2. The authority shall may not issue securities in excess of \$15,000,000 \$35,000,000 outstanding at any one time except for the issuance of revenue 8 refunding securities authorized by section 1609 1610. The amount 10 of securities which ear that may be outstanding in the name of the authority may be increased hereafter by the Legislature, upon 12 a showing by the authority that its available revenues are sufficient to support additional issuance of bonds and that the 14 issuance of bonds will not materially impair the credit standing of the authority, the investment status of bonds issued by the 16 authority or the ability of the authority to fulfill its commitments to bondholders. Nothing in this chapter may be 18 construed to authorize the authority to issue securities to fund the construction, reconstruction, purchase or acquisition of facilities for the use of the Supreme Judicial Court, without 20 approval of the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the Maine Court Facilities Authority to increase its commitment capacity.

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
