HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 839, L.D. 2143, Bill, "An Act to Reestablish the Rangeley Water District"

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

**'Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

**Whereas,** the Town of Rangeley has scheduled on March 16, 1992 a vote on reestablishing the Rangeley Water District; and

**Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**'Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause to the bill.
