HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 844,
L.D. 2148, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Petroleum Market Share
Act"

Amend the amendment in section 3 by striking out all of that
part designated "§1673." and inserting in its place the following:

§1673. Reporting

1. Report by retailer. A retailer of home heating oil shall provide reports to the Department of the Attorney General in a manner, frequency, time and form specified by the Attorney General, but at no greater frequency than 4 times per year, setting forth the total gallons of home heating oil sold to customers in each county from each of its retail outlets.

2. Reports by refiner or wholesaler. A refiner or wholesaler shall make the following reports.

A. Within 30 days of the effective date of this chapter, a refiner or wholesaler controlling retailers or retail outlets shall file with the Department of the Attorney General a list showing the business name and location of each retail outlet controlled by the refiner or wholesaler on the effective date of this chapter and specifying whether the retail outlet sells home heating oil, motor fuel oil or both.

B. Within 60 days of the effective date of this chapter, and every 60 days thereafter, a refiner or wholesaler shall file with the Department of the Attorney General a list showing any changes in the number and location of retail outlets controlled by the refiner or wholesaler during the preceding 60 days.

2 3. Repeal. This section is repealed October 1, 1994.'

4 Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part
designated "§1676." in subsection 1 by inserting at the end the
6 following: 'This subsection does not apply to retail outlets
located within a municipality with a population of 10,000 or more
8 as counted by the 1990 United States Census.'

10 Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part
designated "§1678." in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page
12 5, line 32 in amendment) by striking out the following: "7" and
inserting in its place the following: '9' and in the 2nd line
14 from the end (page 5, line 34 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "5" and inserting in its place the following: '7'

16 Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part
18 designated "§1678." in subsection 2 in the last line (page 5,
line 43 in amendment) by inserting after the following:
20 "matters" the following: 'and one retailer selling less than
7,000,000 gallons per year'

22 Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part
24 designated "§1678." in subsection 3 in the last line (page 5,
line 49 in amendment) by inserting after the following:
26 "matters" the following: 'and one retailer selling less than
7,000,000 gallons per year'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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34 This amendment deletes the separate reporting requirement
for wholesalers and combines wholesaler and refiner reporting,
adds an exemption for large municipalities to the geographic
36 radius anticompetitive trade practices provision and adds 2
retailers to the Petroleum Advisory Committee.
