SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 844, L.D. 2148, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Petroleum Market Share Act"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§1673.~~" by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 3, lines 37 to 42 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§1673.~~" by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§1676.~~" in subsection 1 in the next to the last line (page 4, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "increase" and inserting in its place the following: 'not decrease'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§1676.~~" by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 5, lines 1 to 4 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§1676.~~" by inserting after subsection 4 the following:

'5. Unfair trade practices. A retailer, wholesaler or refiner may not engage in any unfair methods of competition or unfair or deceptive trade practices, as defined by the Attorney General through rules issued under section 1682.'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§1676.~~" by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.


