COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 845, L.D. 2149, Bill, "An Act to Repeal a Provision Concerning Low Sulfur Fuel"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §603-A, sub-§3, as affected by PL 1989, c. 890, Pt. A, §40 and amended by Pt. B, §173, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §603-A, sub-§§5, 6 and 7, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 504, §10, are repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment retains the current standards for low sulfur fuel in law and repeals certain operational requirements. These requirements are addressed in rules of the Department of Environmental Protection.
