An Act to Repeal a Provision Concerning Low Sulfur Fuel.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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38 MRSA §603-A, as affected by PL 1989, c. 890, Pt. A, §40
and amended by Pt. B, §173, is repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to eliminate redundancy and
avoid future conflicts with the state implementation plan for
air. This bill repeals a section of law that also exists in the
form of a Department of Environmental Protection rule.
