COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1526, L.D. 2155, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Motor Vehicle Laws"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 13-B in the last line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "free-flowing" the following: -, including, but not limited to, rubbish, garbage, refuse-derived fuel, scrap materials, junk, refuse, inert fill material and landscape refuse, but not including hazardous waste, biomedical waste, septic tank sludge or agricultural wastes. The fact that a solid waste or constituent of the waste may have value or other use or may be sold or exchanged does not exclude it from this definition'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subparagraph (3) in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 34 and 35 in L.D.) by striking out the following: 'and sanding'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 4.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds clarifying language to the definition of "solid waste" contained in the bill. The amendment also clarifies the bill's language regarding the use of amber lights on snowplows to require the wing light be in use only when the truck is plowing. Finally, the amendment deletes from the bill the section that amended the law governing the conduct of a driver of a vehicle that has been stopped by a law enforcement officer.
