HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1547, L.D. 2185, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of the Laws"

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the fiscal note the following:

PART XX

Sec. XX-1. 5 MRSA Pt. 8, as amended, is repealed.

Sec. XX-2. Intent. The Legislature intends to abolish the State Planning Office as of the effective date of this Act.

Sec. XX-3. Revision required. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters shall report out legislation to the First Regular Session of the 116th Legislature, making necessary revisions in the law to fully implement the abolishment of the State Planning Office.

Sec. XX-4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.
