HOUSE AMENDMENT "G" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1547, L.D. 2185, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of the Laws"

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the fiscal note the following:

PART XX

**Sec. XX-1. Alternative; savings achieved through bargaining.** Notwithstanding Part WW, it is the intent of the Legislature that state employees, through existing bargaining units, negotiate with the appropriate administrators to achieve the same amount of savings as deappropriated and deallocated by Part WW. If negotiations are completed by June 15, 1992 and the Governor certifies that the savings contemplated by Part WW are achieved by a legally binding agreement, then the parties are so bound by the results of the negotiations and Part WW is repealed and is without effect. The terms of the agreement must also be applied to exempt and unrepresented employees in the executive, legislative and judicial branches.

**Sec. XX-2. Calculation; transfer.** Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer shall calculate the amount in sections of this Part that applies against each General Fund, Highway Fund, Federal Expenditure, Other Special Revenue, internal service fund and enterprise fund account for all departments and agencies based on the total General Fund appropriations and various allocations to those accounts. The State Budget Officer shall cause the calculated amount to be transferred from each account.

**Sec. XX-3. Transfer of savings.** Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585 or any other provision of

2 law, the State Budget Officer is authorized to transfer all  
savings occurring as a result of sections 7 to 9 of this Part to  
4 the General Fund as undedicated revenue on a periodic basis, but  
not later than June 30, 1993. The State Budget Officer shall  
6 provide a status report on the amounts being transferred to the  
General Fund by January 15, 1993.

8 **Sec. XX-4. Appropriation.** The following funds are  
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of  
10 this Part.

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Sec. XX-10. Effective date. Sections 2 to 9 of this Part take  
effect only if Part WW is repealed and without effect in  
accordance with section 1 of this Part.'

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Further amend the amendment by relettering the Parts to read  
consecutively.

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FISCAL NOTE

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This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund  
appropriations or revenues and maintains a balanced budget for  
fiscal year 1992-93. The savings required by Part XX go into  
effect only upon the repeal of Part WW.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment provides an alternative to achieve the  
savings required by Part WW of Committee Amendment "A." Under  
this amendment, state employees may negotiate other means to  
achieve the same amount of savings. If the Governor certifies  
that those savings are achieved by a legally binding agreement by  
June 15, 1992, then the parties are bound by the agreement and  
Part WW is repealed.
