the definition of taxable services to include amusement or recreation services and basic cable television service. revenue anticipated from these changes to the taxation laws is used to reduce the reduction in state worker hours in Part WW of the committee amendment.

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This amendment also provides an alternative to achieve the savings required by Part WW of this amendment. Under this. amendment, state employees may negotiate other means to achieve the same amount of savings. If the Governor certifies that those savings are achieved by a legally binding agreement by June 15, 1992, then the parties are bound by the agreement and Part WW is repealed.
