HOUSE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{N} " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1547, L.D. 2185, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of the Laws"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part AA and 20 inserting in its place the following:

'PART AA

Sec. AA-1. Maine Transportation Authority study; transfer. The Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Maine Turnpike Authority and other interested parties, shall evaluate the feasibility of the establishment of the Maine Transportation Authority. The department shall report its findings to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters by January 15, 1993. The Department of Transportation shall transfer \$5,000,000 of operating surplus funds, that are over and above all transfers to the Department of Public Safety and the Department of Transportation required by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, received from the Maine Turnpike Authority to the General Fund by June 30, 1993.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering the parts to read 38 consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund 44 appropriations or revenues and maintains a balanced budget for fiscal year 1991-92 and fiscal year 1992-93.
