Amend the amendment in Part SS in section 2 in the 4th line (page 335, line 46 in amendment) by inserting after the 20 · following: "Center." the following: 'The plan must provide for 22 the delivery of services and treatment that are at least comparable in kinds and levels as are available on the effective 24 date of this Part to those individuals who qualify for those services and treatment whether or not those persons are residents 26 of an institution or are living in the community. This section does not preclude a plan that establishes a different 28 institutional setting if the department finds that it is the most appropriate alternative.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund appropriations or revenues and a balanced budget is maintained for fiscal year 1991-92 and fiscal year 1992-93.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds language to the provision concerning the 42 closure of the Pineland Center to allow the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to establish a different
