HOUSE AMENDMENT "X" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1547, L.D. 2185, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of the Laws"

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 1 under that part designated "MENTAL HEALTH AND MENTAL RETARDATION, DEPARTMENT OF" in that part relating to "Bath Children's Home" by striking out all of the 1st to 5th lines (page 60, lines 14 to 19 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Positions-Legislative Count	(-1.0)
Personal Services	(48,209)
All Other	2,979
	<hr/>
TOTAL	(45,230)

Provides for the deappropriation of funds through the elimination of one Superintendent position.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end of Part WW the following:

'Sec. WW-13. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that on July 1, 1993, the salaries of employees who would have been covered by former Private and Special Law 1991, chapter 65, must be adjusted to reflect the salary levels the employees would have attained pursuant to the appropriations in former Private and Special Law, 1991, chapter 65.'

**FISCAL NOTE**

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This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund appropriations or revenues and a balanced budget is maintained for fiscal year 1991-92 and fiscal year 1992-93.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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This amendment revises the identification of the position to be eliminated to achieve the projected savings.
