HOUSE AMENDMENT "X" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1547, L.D. 2185, Bill, Act "An to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of the Laws"

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 1 under that part 20 designated "MENTAL HEALTH AND MENTAL RETARDATION, DEPARTMENT OF" in that part relating to "Bath Children's Home" by striking out all of the 1st to 5th lines (page 60, lines 14 to 19 in amendment) and inserting in their place the 24 following:

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Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end of Part 38 WW the following:

'Sec. WW-13. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that on July 1, 1993, the salaries of employees who
would have been covered by former Private and Special Law 1991, chapter 65, must be adjusted to reflect the salary levels the
employees would have attained pursuant to the appropriations in former Private and Special Law, 1991, chapter 65.'
