SENATE AMENDMENT "E" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1547, L.D. 2185, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of the Laws"

Amend the amendment by inserting before the fiscal note the following:

PART XX

Sec. XX-1. 5 MRSA §1581 is amended to read:

§1581. Form of appropriation bill

The ~~general--fund~~ General Fund appropriation bill provided for in section 1664 shall must be drawn so as to authorize the appropriation to be made to each department or agency of the State Government for each fiscal year of the biennium. ~~Sueh~~ The appropriation shall must provide specific amounts for personal services, capital expenditures and amounts for all other departmental expenses. Appropriations for the acquisition of property shall must be in such detail under each department or agency as the Governor-elect or the Governor shall ~~determine~~ determines. ~~Sueh~~ Those appropriations shall may not be segregated in greater detail than the major classes or projects for which they are expendable during each fiscal year of the biennium. The Law and Legislative Reference Library established under Title 3, chapter 7, subchapter II must be a separate appropriation not included under any other department or agency in the General Fund appropriation bill.

Sec. XX-2. **Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.
