Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer shall calculate the amount in section 3 of this Part that applies 34 against each General Fund account for all departments and agencies based on the total appropriations to those accounts, 36 except for the following accounts: General Purpose Aid to Local Schools; Education in the Unorganized Territory; Debt Service -38 Treasury; Teacher Retirement; Aid to Families with Dependent Children; Aid to Families with Dependent Children - Foster Care; 40 General Assistance; Maine Health Program; Intermediate Care -Payments to Providers; Medical Care - Payments to Providers; 42 Bureau of Rehabilitation; and Bureau of Rehabilitation 44 Vocational Rehabilitation. FISCAL NOTE

This amendment maintains a balanced budget for the remainder of this biennium only if actual General Fund revenues in fiscal
year 1992-93 do not exceed budgeted revenues by \$3,00,000 by the end of the first quarter of fiscal year 1992-93. The exact
impact of the proposed Part YY can not be determined at this time.
