HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1549, L.D. 2187, Bill, "An Act
to Permit Pari-mutuel Pools"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement
of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 8 MRSA §274-A, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 579,
§11, is amended to read:

6. Operation of facility. An off-track betting licensee
may not permit a person under the age of 16 to enter the facility
unless accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or custodian, as
defined in Title 22, section 4002. The off-track betting
licensee may not permit any person under the age of ~~16~~ 18 within
15 feet of any betting window or other place for accepting
wagers.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the age a person may be near a
betting window or other place for accepting wagers from 16 to 18
years of age.
