An Act to Clarify Earnable Compensation for Retirement Purposes.

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	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

	B. "Earnable compensation" does not include:
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	(1) For any member who has 7 years of creditable
10	<u>service by December 1, 1991 or who has reached 60 years</u>
	<u>of age and has been in service for a minimum of one</u>
12	year immediately before that date, payment for more
	than 30 days of unused accumulated or accrued sick
14	leave, payment for more than 30 days of unused vacation
16	leave or payment for more than 30 days of a combination
	<u>of both;</u>
18	(2) For any member who is not covered by subsection 1,
TO	payment for any unused accumulated or accrued sick
20	leave or payment for any unused vacation leave;
