COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 875, L.D. 2236, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Degree Granting Authority of Husson College"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "Sec. 1." by striking out all of the last line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'study.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "Sec. 2." in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 14 and 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "in any of the fields of science instruction,"

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects 2 improper references in the original bill that would have limited the authority of Husson College to grant bachelor of science degrees and associate science degrees.
