
SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1591, L.D. 2245, Bill, "An Act to Strengthen the Public Disclosure of Lobbying Activities"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 9 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 24 in amendment) by striking out the following: "with" and inserting in its place the following: 'or with' and in the 4th to 6th lines (page 1, lines 25 to 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "or with any administrative official for the purpose of influencing any administrative action"

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes from the definition of "lobbying" communications with administrative officials for the purpose of influencing administrative action. Those activities are not included in the current statutory definition of "lobbying."
