SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1591, L.D. 2245, Bill, "An Act to Strengthen the Public Disclosure of Lobbying Activities"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. 3 MRSA §312-A, sub-§10-A is enacted to read:

10-A. Meals and entertainment activity. "Meals and entertainment activity" means the provision of a meal or entertainment to 5 or more officials in the legislative branch or administrative officials or both at a single event, whether or not the provision is for the purpose of influencing a legislative or administrative action.'

Further amend the amendment after the 9th paragraph after the title, by inserting after line 38 (page 2 in amendment) the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 8 in subsection 1, in paragraph F in the 3rd line (page 3, line 40 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "branch" the following: 'or administrative officials'

Further amend the bill in section 8 in subsection 1, in paragraph G in the 2nd line (page 3, line 46 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "branch" the following: 'or administrative officials'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of paragraphs K and L (page 2, lines 49 to 52 and page 3, lines 2 to 7 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

2 'K. A section in which a lobbyist may indicate through a  
3 check mark that the lobbyist did not participate in any  
4 lobbying activities, receive compensation or receive  
5 reimbursement for expenses for that month;


6 L. A section in which a lobbyist may indicate through a  
7 check mark that the lobbyist requests an exemption under  
8 subsection 1-A. This section must clearly state that the  
9 lobbyist intends not to perform lobbying activities, receive  
10 compensation or receive reimbursement for expenditures until  
11 the Legislature convenes in a regular or special session; and

12 M. The date and total amount of money expended for each  
13 meal and entertainment activity. This paragraph does not  
14 apply to a meal or entertainment activity for which a  
15 lobbyist spends \$50 or less'

16  
17 Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to  
18 read consecutively.  
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22 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

23 This amendment adds a definition of "meals and entertainment  
24 activity," which means the provision of a meal or entertainment  
25 to 5 or more legislative or administrative officials at a single  
26 event, whether or not the event is related to a pending matter,  
27 and requires reporting of meals and entertainment activities if  
28 they exceed \$50. The amendment also requires reporting of  
29 lobbying expenditures made to influence administrative officials  
30 as well as legislative branch officials.
