HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1594, L.D. 2248, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Maine's Rent-to-own Laws"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§11-106." in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the last 2 lines (page 4, lines 24 and 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "or with an organization"

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§11-109." in subsection 8 in the 3rd line (page 7, line 10 in amendment) by striking out the following: "at least" and inserting in its place the following: 'more than'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§11-120." by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 13, lines 36 to 40 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'3. A civil action by an aggrieved consumer in which the consumer may recover actual damages or \$250, whichever is greater, plus costs of the action and reasonable attorney's fees.'
