An Act to Clarify Certain Classifications under the Prevailing Wage Laws.



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	26 MRSA	<b>§1306.</b>	as	amended by	PL	1975,	c.	59,	§3,	is	further
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amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

A minimum wage may not be established for any so-called helper classification of any trade or occupation except for those helper classifications licensed under the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation pursuant to Title 32.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

Under this bill, a separate minimum wage may be set for a helper classification in a trade or occupation only if such a classification is licensed under the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32.

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
