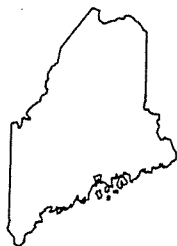

**An Act Regarding County Contingent Account Limits.**

---

(AFTER DEADLINE)



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §922, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1989, c. 6;  
4 c. 9, §2 and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to  
read:

2. **Contingent fund.** There is established a contingent  
8 account in each county in an amount not to exceed \$50,000  
\$100,000 annually. Any funds that are available to each county  
10 may be used for this purpose. This fund may be used at the  
discretion of the county commissioners for emergency purposes  
12 only. At the end of each fiscal year there shall must be  
transferred from unencumbered county funds an amount sufficient  
14 to restore the established county contingent account.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill increases the limit on the amount of money that  
20 may be kept in a contingent account in each county from \$50,000  
to \$100,000.
