HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1601, L.D. 2263, Bill, "An Act to Repeal Increases in Concealed Weapons Permit Fees and to Increase the Fees Related to Arbitrations under the Lemon Law"

Amend the amendment by adding before the fiscal note the following:

'Sec. 5. 25 MRSA §2003, sub-§14 is enacted to read:

14. Lapsed permit. A person may apply for renewal of a permit at the permit renewal rate at any time within 6 months after expiration of a permit. A person who applies for a permit more than 6 months after the expiration date of the permit last issued to that person must submit an original application and pay the original application fee.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that a person who applies for renewal of a concealed firearms permit within 6 months after expiration of their permit may receive a permit renewal at the permit renewal fee rate. A person who waits more than 6 months after expiration of a permit to apply for a renewal is considered to be making an original application for a permit.
