SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1601, L.D. 2263, Bill, "An Act to Repeal Increases in Concealed Weapons Permit Fees and to Increase the Fees Related to Arbitrations under the Lemon Law"

Amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of subparagraph (4) and inserting in its place the following:

'(4) Submits an application fee of \$60 ~~\$35~~ for an original application, \$15 ~~\$10~~ of which must be retained by the municipality and \$45 ~~\$25~~ of which must be paid over by the municipality to the Treasurer of State, and \$60 ~~\$20~~ for a renewal, \$15 ~~\$5~~ of which must be retained by the municipality and \$45 ~~\$15~~ of which must be paid over by the municipality to the Treasurer of State, for a resident of the State. A person who paid \$60 for a concealed weapons permit or renewal during 1991 or 1992 is entitled to a credit toward renewal fees in an amount equal to \$30 for a person who paid \$60 for an original application and \$45 for a person who paid \$60 for a permit renewal. The credit is valid until fully utilized. The fee covers both the cost of processing the application by the issuing authority and the cost of the permit to carry concealed firearms issued by the issuing authority; and'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 8 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 18 in amendment) by striking out the figure "3" and inserting in its place the following: '3 4' and in the 2nd line from the end (page 2, line 21 in amendment) by striking out the figure "3" and inserting in its place the figure '4'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:
