COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1601, L.D. 2263, Bill, "An Act to Repeal Increases in Concealed Weapons Permit Fees and to Increase the Fees Related to Arbitrations under the Lemon Law"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act Regarding Concealed Weapons Permit Fees'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2003, sub-§1, ¶E, as amended by PL 1991, c. 591, Pt. EE, §1, is further amended by amending subparagraph (4):

(4) Submits an application fee of ~~\$60~~ \$30 for an original application, ~~\$15~~ \$20 of which must be retained by the municipality and ~~\$45~~ \$10 of which must be paid over by the municipality to the Treasurer of State, and ~~\$60~~ \$15 for a renewal, ~~\$15~~ \$10 of which must be retained by the municipality and ~~\$45~~ \$5 of which must be paid over by the municipality to the Treasurer of State, for a resident of the State. A person who paid \$60 for a concealed weapons permit or renewal during 1991 or 1992 is entitled to a credit toward renewal fees in an amount equal to \$30 for a person who paid \$60 for an original application and \$45 for a person who paid \$60 for a permit renewal. The credit is valid until fully utilized. The fee covers both the cost of processing the application by the issuing authority and the cost of the permit to carry concealed firearms issued by the issuing authority; and
