An Act to Allow Municipalities to Operate Stump Dumps.

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	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
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	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1310-N, as amended by PL 1991, c. 622, Pt.
4	X, $\S14$, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph
	to read:

	The disposal of wood wastes generated within a municipality
8	is exempt from the requirements of this chapter when the facility
	is owned and operated by a municipality and the waste is burned
10	on-site at least twice each year, regardless of whether the
	facility is otherwise subject to licensure under this chapter for
12	<u>other waste management activities.</u>

	This bill allows municipalities to operate disposal
18	facilities for burning brush, tree stumps and other wood wastes
	that are not mixed with other waste.

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
