COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1614, L.D. 2275, "Resolve,  
Concerning the Removal of Residential Underground Oil Tanks"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line  
25 in L.D.) by inserting before the following: "residential" the  
following: 'registered'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the 2nd line (page  
1, line 40 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "own" the  
following: 'registered'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the  
statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

Costs associated with implementing a group contract for the  
removal of certain residential underground oil tanks can be  
absorbed by the Department of Environmental Protection utilizing  
existing budgeted resources.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment requires that underground oil storage tanks  
that are removed pursuant to a contract developed by the  
Department of Environmental Protection be registered. The  
amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
