2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §606, sub-§1-A,** as enacted by PL 1991, c.
227, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

6 1-A. Exception. Notwithstanding subsection 1, a person
7 licensed to sell spirits for consumption on the premises that is
8 located at least 15 miles from the nearest state liquor store may
9 purchase spirits from an agency liquor store.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill permits an on-premises liquor licensee, such as a
15 restaurant or bar, to purchase spirits at agency liquor stores,
16 without an 8% markup and without written approval, if the
17 licensee is 15 miles or more from the nearest state liquor store.
