## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1310-D, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 517, $\S$ 25, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: 4 б The provisions of this article govern open-municipal solid waste landfills. 8 Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §1310-D, sub-§3, ¶A, as amended by PL 1991, c. 374, §4 and repealed and replaced by c. 519, §5, is repealed and 10 the following enacted in its place: 12 Within 90 days of the receipt of a landfill evaluation, together with the recommendations for closure and, if any, 14remediation actions, the commissioner shall issue an order 16 for closure and, if appropriate, remediation. This order must specify the use of compost or reclaimed soil materials for landfill cover to the maximum extent practical and 18 consistent with sound environmental practices. Subject to 20 sections 1310-F and 1310-G, a timetable for implementation and all pertinent cost-sharing must be included as part of 22 the order. Sec. 3. 38 MRSA §1310-D, sub-§6 is enacted to read: 24 26 6. Exempt. An island that is not connected to the mainland by a bridge, causeway or any other structure providing passage to 28 the island is exempt from this section. 30 STATEMENT OF FACT 32 This bill exempts islands that are not connected to the mainland from the law requiring closure of existing landfills. 34 The bill also corrects a conflict created by 2 public laws

36 amending the same section.
