HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1634, L.D. 2298, Bill, "An Act to Allow the Separation of Certain Islands in Casco Bay from the City of Portland"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, negotiations required by this legislation must be completed by June 30, 1992; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, ' '

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title (page 1, line 17 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the last paragraph before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

2 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'
